DIRECTIONS TO SITE

Coming from I5 North take the first Grants Pass exit, go all the way through town crossing the bridge. Go straight onto Hwy 238- Williams Hwy. Stay on Williams Hwy. Make a right on Grays Creek Rd, left on Copper Drive. Will see signs for Bar W Ranch. Drive slowly to the left on the driveway back to barn.

Coming from I5 South, take the first Grants Pass exit. This puts you on 199, go down to Hwy 238- Williams Hwy, turn left onto 238. Stay on Williams Hwy. Make a right on Grays Creek Rd, left on Copper Drive. Will see signs for Bar W Ranch. Drive slowly to the left on the driveway back to barn. 506 Copper Drive, Grants Pass

ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: Your entry must be RECEIVED by June 13, 2025, to be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **RCA** You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- O It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Aggressive behavior by any dog will not be tolerated. Any aggressive behavior will result in the Trial Committee evaluating the situation and determining whether any action is necessary, up to the removal of a competitor from the tournament.
- O All participants in TDAA events, including competitors, judges, regional master judges, trial chairs, secretaries, members, vendors, handlers, owners of dogs, and anyone else involved with a TDAA event must refrain from behavior detrimental to the confidence, or the public perception, of the TDAA's events and integrity.
- O Those involved in the TDAA's events must behave in ways that do not negatively reflect on dog agility and the TDAA
- O Conduct by anyone that is reckless, careless, perilous, turbulent, violent, or illegal puts others at risk, damages the reputation of others in the TDAA organization, and undercuts public respect and support for the TDAA is to be avoided.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling, verbal abuse of trial personnel, or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring, and possibly expulsion from the tournament.
- O All dogs must be always on leash except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the current edition of TDAA's Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.

RULES REGARDING USE OF FOOD AND TOYS IN THE RING TDAA has issued rules regarding the use of food and toys in the ring. Food treats and toys can be used in the rind to reward the dog if they are not used to lure the dog, change the dog's direction or induce performance in any way. Using food or a toy to induce performance will result in a 20-point fault. Food and toys cannot be visible or audible while the dog is performing. Sections 5.2.2.11 and 5.2.2.12 provide additional details. Questions regarding this rule change will be addressed during the General Briefing each day of the trial.

Obstacle Familiarization - obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday morning 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs.

Warm-ups - a warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all Exhibitors.

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs **20-inches** and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a prior show up to the closing date. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. "Move-up Request Form" is set out later in premium and available on the Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4 th place in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered.

The following is a list of obstacles to be used: (All TDAA size):

A-frame (6'8" sides w/slats) Weave Poles (20" centers)

Table (30" sides)

Winged Jumps Tire Jump (18" loop)

Open (pipe) Tunnel (16" loop) Dog Walk (8' planks w/o slats)

Teeter (8' plank) (w/out slats)

Jumps without wings

Games Classes

Games I - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II - Only dogs who have earned Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III - Only dogs who have earned Games II (TG2) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Cowboy Dog-This is a numbered course which includes among the obstacles a barrel. The dog's turn around the barrel must be clockwise (counterclockwise turn is a wrong course). When a barrel is used with other agility obstacles it should be plenty of real estate on every side so that it stands apart. Give the dog and handler room to work. Scoring Cowboy Dog is scored time plus faults. The lowest score wins.

Jackpot-Jackpot is run a game where handler determines what obstacles and direction to send dog. The Dog must earn required points for their level, in the stated amount of time. Judge may specify certain sections on the course the dog can earn extra point values by performing a section judge specifies. Jackpot is scored Points, Then Time.

Colors- The objective is to successfully negotiate one of two overlapping agility mini-courses. The handler may choose which course to run. Each course is labeled with colored markers. Scoring Colors is scored Faults, Then Time. The winner is the dog with the fewest faults.

Jumpers- Jumpers courses consist only of hurdles and tunnels. The dog is required to run the course in the sequence indicated by the judge. Follow the numbers. And keep the bars up is judge. Scoring Jumpers is usually scored Faults, Then Time, the winner being the dog with the fewest faults. If two dogs have the same number of Faults, Then Time breaks the tie.

Jump Height Divisions:

TDAA offers the following Jump Height Divisions: 2", 4", 8", 12", 16". Owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog at the proper height division, both the dog's measured jump height and the height at which they want their dog to jump at the trial. Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired; however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

Jump Height Exemptions (only applicable for National or Regional Competitions):

In national or regional competitions, such as the Petit Prix, dogs are required to jump at their measured height, as adjusted for any jump height exemptions to which they are entitled. Jump height exemptions are provided for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see kgtdaa.com, TDAA Rules and Regulations, Sec. 3.5.3 for descriptions of jump height exemptions). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs at least 7 years of age) and a second exemption (two jump heights) will be granted to "double digit" veterans (dogs at least 10 years of age). You may subtract one height for veteran status, one for double digit veteran status, and one for body exemption from Measured Jump Height.

Disabled Handlers: A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes. Proof of disability shall be a copy of the handler's disability parking tag or other official documentation, which must be included with the entry or presented at check-in at the trial.

Entries

Entries close **June 13**, 2025, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Day of Event Entries **WILL BE** accepted **up to 7:30** each morning, for an additional \$2.00 per run. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official Entry forms. One dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries, without the signed TDAA Agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check(s). Subsequent returned check(s) from the same Exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
